John Lee began playing the piano at the age of four. He has performed thrice at the ABRSM High Scorers' Concerts for his Grade 5, 7 and 8 examinations in 2003, 2004 and 2005 respectively. He obtained his ATCL (Recital) Diploma with distinction in 2006 at the age of twelve, and the LTCL (Recital) Diploma with distinction in 2010.

John was a finalist at the 2009 International Chopin Piano Competition in Asia held in Tokyo, Japan and in the open category of the 2011 Mozart International Piano Competition held in Bangkok, Thailand. He has also won the Third Prize in the Open Category of the 2009 Young Pianist Competition held in Singapore. John is a Year 6 student in Raffles Institution and was the Principal Cellist and Vice-Chairman of the Raffles Institution String Ensemble.

He is also active in his school's Music Elective Programme and was the top student for Music in 2008, 2009 and 2011. John also has an interest in jazz, and performs often with Raffles Jazz. He is currently under the tutelage of Mr Benjamin Loh.
